Following are some TOEFL sample speaking questions for this topic:

1. Do you agree that experienced doctors are better than young ones?
2. Do you agree or disagree that the youth should learn more about domestic chores along with their studies?
3. Indian students aspiring to study abroad must be fluent in a foreign language other than English. Do you agree or disagree?
4. Male and female students should have separate living halls. Do you agree or disagree?
5. Elaborate upon your agreement or disagreement on the fact that celebrities should not hide their personal life issues with the media

Preference Type Questions

1. What are your views on using brand new books rather than using old books?
2. Will you choose to study for a few hours and having a full night's sleep or studying for the entire comprising of your sleep?
3. Do you prefer calling some directly or just texting? Why?
4. Some students like to watch educational programs on TV and some prefer entertainment programs. Which one will you prefer and why?
5. Some students prefer to switch off their phones while studying and some use it for the same. Which one do you prefer choosing and why?

TOEFL Speaking Question 1 Samples

3. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

Provide details and examples to explain your opinion.

4. Do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

“Video games have a positive impact on children.”

Provide reasons and examples to support your stance.

5. People learn in different ways. Some people learn by doing, other people learn by reading, and others learn by listening to people. Which of these methods of learning is best for you?
