Part 1 - Introduction & Interview.

Q. What is your hometown like?

Q. Can you describe it for me?

Q. Can you tell me something about the history of your hometown?

Q. Is your hometown changing? [Why? /Why not?]

Q. Would you say it is a good place to live? Why?

Part Two - Cue Card/ Candidate Task Card.

Topic:

Describe an equipment of your household (such as a computer, television, refrigerator, mobile phone and so on).

You should say:

what is it

what you do with it

whether you will always keep it or not

and explain why it is so important to you.

[You will have to talk about the topic for one to two minutes. You have one minute to think about what you are going to say. You can make some notes to help you if you wish.]

Rounding-off Questions:

Q. Do you have a computer at home?

Q. How often do you access the internet?

Part 3 - Details Discussion.

Q. How about the use of modern devices and tools by the families in your country?

Q. What development do you believe the technology will bring in the future?

Q. Do you think these developments are important? How is so?

Q. How the use of technology can affect the relationship of family members?

Q. Should we use all the technology and tools available in the market to make our life better? Why /Why not?
